

After tryouts - what's next?

Your coach or team manager will inform you of your status with the team. Some make direct phone calls, some pass out letters on the second day.

Once accepted to a team, you must:

1. Complete the registration process through your established account as detailed at plymouthsoccer.net
2. Submit all paperwork, proof-of-birth copy, player photo and minimum \$200 first payment to a club representative at the Plymouth Cultural Center (525 Farmer St., Plymouth) before June 25, 2009. Service hours are posted at plymouthsoccer.net.
3. Sizing for uniforms will also take place at the Plymouth Cultural Center during service hours.
